Flexible dining plans are now available allowing students to purchase on-campus options. Dining plans start at AUD\$1,760 and can be used at the following dining outlets: Café Bond, Brasserie, Don's, Papyrus Café and the University Club. If you are residing off campus, dining plans start from AUD\$110. It is compulsory to select a dining plan with all on-campus accommodation. All rooms include telephone, internet connection, desk and chair, single bed, wardrobe, bookshelves and bedside drawers. An AUD\$600 down payment on accommodation is required at the time of booking.
