BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

Supporting documentation

Check the conditions section of your 'Letter of Offer' and make sure that you have submitted all the required documentation (such as certified copies of your secondary school education certificate, translated copies of transcripts and so on). Any outstanding documents must be delivered to the Office of Admissions before you can enrol in classes. You can submit this at any time prior to Orientation Week. Alternatively it can be given to the Admissions staff in the Enrolment Hub during Orientation week.

Computer account

If you haven't already activated your computer account online (http://apps.bond.edu.au/ student-accounts) Information Services staff in the Main Library can help you. Your computer account is essential for accessing your Bond University email, the student computers, wireless network, iLearn and more. Your Bond email address is where all university correspondence will be sent, so make sure you check your emails regularly.

Subject enrolment

If you haven't enrolled in your subjects online via eStudent (www.bond.edu.au/eStudent), you should speak with our eStudent Support Crew or your Faculty Program Advisor in the Enrolment Hub to finalise your subject enrolment and class timetable. Please note that your eStudent login is different from your computer account (see above). After you have enrolled in your subjects via eStudent and activated your computer account, go to www.mytimetable.bond.edu.au to select the classes you will be attending this semester.


Student Activities Membership and parking permit






